Where are my favourites displayed?

Your favourites are displayed both in the product area and in your favourites list.

5 You will find a selection of your favourites under „your favourites“ on the right-hand side of the product area.



Your „favourites“ only appear on the right-hand side if you have saved articles from the selected articles class as favourites.

Example: if you are in the butt welding fittings article class, you will only be able to see your favourites from the butt welding fittings article class on the right-hand side!
